

PULMONARY FUNCTION TESTING (PFT)

PFTs are a group of tests that measure how well your lungs work.

This includes how well you're able to breathe and how effective your lungs are able to bring oxygen to the rest of your body.

This test can detect asthma, COPD, LD and other lung disorders.

The need for Pulmonary Function Testing:

Inhalation of some dusts, gases, or other air contaminants in your workplace as well as some personal experience, such as cigarette smoking, can harm your lungs. Pulmonary Function Testing may identify breathing problems early, which may prevent more serious problems.

PFTs are required for some workers by OSHA standards. Testing may be required on workers who are required to perform job tasks that are physically demanding, require wearing a respirator, or cause exposure to certain possible breathing hazards.
